
1. Introduction: some key figures about Swiss forestry







Forestry, an economic activity which enhances 31% of the Swiss territory





Some key figures of Swiss forestry (2012)

Public owners	9'000 (70% forest area)
Private owners	240'000 (30% forest area)
Jobs (companies)	6300 jobs (5000 FTE) (2012)
Jobs (incl. households)	8000 FTE (source: EAF)
Volume standing timber	450 million m3 (NFI ø2009-13)
Annual timber removals	4,7 million m3 (source: FSO)
Gross value added	310 million CHF
Part in total Swiss GVA	0,05% Sources:

## **National Accounts and forestry**

- → International standards in national accounting (UN, EU); strong cooperation between international agencies (UN, FAO, World Bank, IMF, Eurostat):
  - central framework (core of National Accounts)
  - satellite accounts (and bridges to NA)

### **→** Forestry:

- ☑ branch (industry) in national economy: production account, input/output tables (IOT)
- ☑ specific coordinated satellite accounts for forestry
- ☑ bridges between the satellite accounts and to NA




# Forestry and logging activities




Economic activity (industries)	Products	Relevance for CH
Silviculture and other forestry activities	forest nurseries, standing timber	Yes
Logging	Wood in the rough (sawlogs, fire wood, industry wood)	Yes
Gathering of wild growing non-wood products	mushrooms, berries, resin, cork, moss, etc.	No
Support services to forestry	Support services to forestry and logging, contract work	Yes

# **Accounting construction**

### Elements of accounting sequence are...

- → Production process: creating value added [production account]
- → Generation of primary income: operating surplus, mixed income, entrepreneurial income [generation of income and entrepreneurial income accounts]
- → Accumulation: renewal of productive assets [elements of capital account]
- → Productive assets [elements of balance sheets]






## From output to income

intermediate output +900 Production process consumption +400 = gross value added consumption of fixed capital Depreciation = net value added +200 other other taxes Distribution State 


⇔ enterprises +150 subsidies on production on production +300 = factor income compensation of employees Remuneration of salaried labour = net operating surplus -100 mixed income interest interest Remuneration of property (capital, land) & rent, +30 & rent, payable receivable = net entrepreneurial income






## **Perspectives**

- → Yearly production
- → New in 2016: Introduction of the economic valuation of standing timber
  - = partial implementation of IEEAF / FA
  - ☐ Balance sheet standing timber (physical, m3)
  - ☐ Balance sheet standing timber (monetary, CHF)
  - □ Variations closing stock opening stock
  - ☐ net annual increment of standing timber (output)
  - ☐ removals of standing timber (intermediate consump.)
