INFORMATIONS ÉVENTUELLES TRANSMISES PAR LE PARTENAIRE

Day of arrival

Students should arrive at least one week before the beginning of classes. Students who arrive after the beginning of classes will have some delay in getting their IDs and in the activation of the university facilities. Arrivals after the first week of classes will not be



permitted. Recommended arrival dates: autumn semester 5th August and spring semester 5th March

Semester Spanish Program

The courses (intermediate and advanced) offer 4 credits (4 hours a week). Registration runs the same as for the regular courses. There is a placement test and spaces are limited.

Spanish Language and Peruvian Studies (February/August)

This program offers formal instruction in for a total of twenty hours per week. Students attend a daily two-hour session where they receive formal instruction in Spanish Grammar, as well as focusing on the development of oral and written communicational skills. Besides, students are supervised by teaching assistants, for a daily two-hour individualized conversational practice. In addition, the program offers 4 courses on different aspects of Peruvian culture. It also includes one guided visit per week to important cultural sites in Lima.
